OCT. 3 | Praise God for how our coaches have served as beacons of hope within their communities during the pandemic! Pray that they would persevere in ministry, be renewed in their passion and be grounded in the gospel as they disciple their teams. { *Galatians 6:9* }



Churches

OCT. 4 | Pray for church leaders and pastors around the world that we partner with. Pray that they would grasp the power of sports to reach those in their communities who are living and dying without Christ. Pray that they would encourage many in their churches to become coaches. { *John 13:34-35* }

OCT. 5 | We praise God for a diverse, unified team that is passionate about young people coming to know Christ through sports ministry! OCT. 6 | Pray that God would open doors for us to push forward into new areas and new communities that are least reached with the gospel. Pray that God would raise up new workers to help us reach those who don't have access to our hope in Christ. { *Luke 10:2* }

OCT. 7 | As we partner with local communities and churches globally, pray that God would grant us discernment on how to respond wisely to the needs presented by COVID-19 and other global challenges. Pray that God would provide resources for us to intervene when needed. { *Ephesians 3:20-21* }
